HOUSTON CBP RECURRING ISSUES AND INFORMATION

April 20, 2022

- A valid TN visa holder may change employers by departing the United States and seek reentry at a POE, with a valid TN visa as long as the TN visa holder has the required documentation, and the fees are paid. 8 CFR 214.6(h)(2) and (i)(2).
- Applicants for admission in either primary or secondary inspection do not have the right to legal representation unless the Applicant for admission has become the focus of a criminal investigation and has been taken into custody. (8 CFR 292.5, CBP Inspector's Field Manual Section 2.9 and Adjudicator's Field Manual Chapters 8 and 12.)
- The best way to correct I-94 errors or omissions on the travel history, is by going to the Deferred Inspection Office.

Houston Deferred Inspection Office does not accept requests for I94 corrections via email. The request for correction of the Form I94 must be made in person during office hours. There are 77 deferred inspection offices in the U.S. 22 of these offices accept requests for Form I94 corrections via email. There are no jurisdictional issues when requesting these I94 corrections in any of the deferred action offices.

- E2 Visa Holders when being admitted to the U.S. under visa revalidation, may be admitted for up to 2 years. The two- year admission is not automatic according to CBP local guidance. Please review the admission requirements for visa revalidation. 22 CFR Section 41.112(d); 9 FAM 403.9.
