

New Americans in Texas



16.4% of Texans are foreign born

42.0% are Latino or Asian



33.2% of immigrants in the state are naturalized U.S. citizens

11.8% of registered voters are New Americans



87.7% of children with immigrant parents are U.S. citizens

75.2% of children with immigrant parents are English proficient



70.7% of naturalized citizens have a high school diploma or higher

61,511 foreign students contribute **\$1.4 billion** to the state economy



Make up **21%** of the workforce.

9% of the workforce is unauthorized.



DID YOU KNOW?

Texas would lose **\$69.3 billion** in economic activity and about **403,174 jobs** if all unauthorized immigrants were removed.

Latino-owned businesses had sales and receipts of **\$61.9 billion** and employed **395,673** people

Asian-owned businesses had sales and receipts of **\$40.2 billion** and employed **206,545** people

The purchasing power of Latinos is **\$216.2 billion**. Asian buying power totaled **\$48.8 billion**.
