AIRPORT TRANSFERS

Taxis are available at the airport with fares around MXN \$450 for a one-way trip in a sedan. Opt for authorized companies like Porto Taxi, Sitio 300, Nueva Imagen, Comfort Plus, or Yellow Cab for a safe experience. You can purchase your transfer ticket at booths inside the airport. You will pay in advance for your ride and can tip the driver upon arrival at your destination.

Round Trip (Airport AICM - Hotel – Airport AICM):

Private sedan car (up to 3 people) MXN \$1,618.20 pesos, taxes included.

Private Van (up to 6 people) MXN \$2,427.30 pesos, taxes included.



GETTING AROUND THE CITY

The conference hotel is in the heart of the city and many neighborhoods are close and walkable.

Many individuals also take Ubers to get around. Uber in CDMX is considered safe and an easy way to get around the city. Most Ubers will arrive for pick up in 5 minutes or less, sometimes a few minutes longer if you're outside the main areas. Your existing Uber app will work in Mexico City, all you need is Wi-Fi. Mexico City has free Wi-Fi including the citywide Wi-Fi and free Wi-Fi available in almost every restaurant and cafe. When you open the Uber app in Mexico City it will use your phone's location services to recognize that you're in Mexico and all the prices will be shown and charged in Mexican Pesos.
