What is CeBONDS?

Cash Electronic Bonds (CeBONDS) is a web-based system that allows users to verify bond information, post cash immigration bonds for detained noncitizens, and receive electronic notifications from ICE.

Who can post a Cash Bond?

The following persons/entities can utilize CeBONDS to post cash delivery bonds:

- U.S. Citizens
- Lawful Permanent Residents
- Law Firms
- Nonprofit Organizations
- Noncitizens may post an OSUP bond or Voluntary Departure bond on their own behalf



Benefits of CeBONDS?



Convenience

Obligors may post and track an immigration bond from anywhere with an internet connection.

Paperless

Electronically storing data in CeBONDS significantly reduces use of paper and storage space.

Tracking

CeBONDS allows obligors to track the status of a cash bond without calling or walking into an office.

How to use CeBONDS?

1. Navigate to www.ICE.gov/bonds
2. Select “Click Here to Post a Bond”
3. Register for a secure CeBONDS account



Once your account has been created, you will navigate directly to CeBONDS after selecting “Click Here to Post a Bond.”
